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Case: This is a clinical informatics and information practice with about 100 people trying to share content and distill it into new useable content. Focus on collaboration piece - culture and people are not a problem because the group is small and cohesive. They just want a simpler mechanism for sharing informally, with minimal structure or formats being imposed on them.

Ideally, they would like social tools that are in common use on the Internet (e.g. Facebook) to be implemented within the content capture and retention framework of the current infrastructure.

They want the ability to add metadata at the paragraph level, and add annotation as they use content resources that have been shared.
